

Creative Camp Policies and Reminders



Food: Please, no sugary or chocolate snacks! This makes our little campers excited and we like to promote healthy eating. Also, if one child has special treats and another doesn't, it presents situations.

Lunch: Please pack child's lunch in a brown paper bag with their name clearly written on the front. We will provide the bags if you need them. Include utensils if necessary, however, if they are not disposable, please write their names on them as well. Don't forget that every Friday is our Pizza party and pizza is complimentary of Muzart – so you won't need to pack lunch on that day. (enjoy your 15 minutes!)

Change of clothes: Please bring your child to the Muzart Studios dressed in clothes that could be used for art and could be stained. During water play days, dress your child with a bathing suit underneath. (inquire within when these days will be) Do not forget socks or flip flops if your child is sensitive to walking around outside bare foot! We do not paint in our closed shoes. Please pack a clean change of clothes that they will be changed into after art/water play – in a zip lock with their name on it. Also bring for their cubby, another change of clothes (a top, bottom, socks and diaper or under garment) in a zip lock with their name on it in case of an accident. (We provide the zip locks as well if you need one)

Art Projects/Shows: Our little campers will be doing individual art projects daily but will also be working on one big project together during week long camps that will be unveiled on Friday to our parents as a surprise! At times it will be an art project and at times it may be a show. This will promote team work and commitment. On Friday, please arrive at 2pm sharp for the unveil or the show.

Drop Off & Pick Up: During camp, the parking lot in the back will be locked. We have assigned one location only for drop off and pick for security purposes. Drop Off & Pick Up will be in the gym reception area in the front of the building ONLY. Please look for the sign that will direct you to the camp door and knock. Bring your child(ren) to the yellow room facing the gym as you enter. Someone will be there to assist you. Pick up will be done in the same manner.



Our Discipline Policy

The Muzart Konnection would like to reiterate our policy regarding discipline and aggressive behavior during Creative Camp.

Please be aware that here at Muzart's Creative Camp, foul language, hitting, biting, and any other extremely aggressive behavior is unacceptable. Muzart is a loving, close knit environment, and while we discipline our children lovingly without using "time-out's" but redirecting our children, we will not tolerate aggressive behavior. Our camp revolves around age appropriate, yet mature materials and all children need the full attention of their teachers. Extremely disruptive behavior is not only inappropriate, but could be unsafe in some instances.

Children will be children, but if there is a situation where a child is disrupting the camp, and the safety of the children, we will follow the following steps.

First, we will work with the child to redirect their attention and give them a chore or additional work to keep their energy focused in a positive direction. If that doesn't help, we give them a break and they will sit on a couch or a table where it isn't as fun as being with their friends. Lastly, we will call a parent to come and pick up the child.

If the child has to be sent home 3 times or if we have 3 incidents of hitting, biting or other aggressive or foul behavior at camp, that child will not be able to return to camp. In this instance, refunds will not be available.

Please understand that at Muzart, we have something for everyone in your family, but we want each experience to be that of a loving, kind and enjoyable one. Aggressiveness or disruptive behavior is not only unacceptable but very unsafe during camp and safety is our priority.

Parking at Muzart

Please be advised that the building north of ours has private parking spots in front of their property and my students are **not** allowed to pull up there. (Not even for a minute!) If you have other children in the car and do not want to cross the street for drop off and pick up, we will be happy to come outside and help. We want our children to arrive and get home safely but that is not our property and we want to respect our neighbors. If you would like assistance, please call a few minutes before arrival so we could expect you or speak to someone at Muzart if you would like to make regular arrangements for help with your drop off and pick up times.
